SUBJECT: Public Notification of Application to operate as a Centralized Examination Station Solicitation at Port of Port Everglades/Fort Lauderdale International Airport, Fort Lauderdale, Florida

PURPOSE

This Information Bulletin is issued to inform the importing community that one application was received from an interested party to be considered to operate a Centralized Examination Station (CES) for Port Everglades, Florida and invite the public to submit any relevant written comments concerning the applicant.

BACKGROUND

This application to operate as a CES for Port Everglades, Florida was received in response to Information Bulletin No. 18-28, dated July 23, 2018, which announced a 60-day open period for applications from interested parties to be considered as a CES at the Port of Port Everglades, Florida. The 60-day open period commenced on July 24, 2018 and expired on September 24, 2018.
